Charles's Column

Warren Buffet, billionaire investor and founder of Berkshire Hathaway last week became the most generous philanthropist in history. His announcement that he will give \$31 Billion to the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation more than doubled the assets of the largest U.S. philanthropy. The "Oracle of Omaha" indicated that his decision about giving away most of his vast fortune was closely related to his investment decisions. The same thorough research and analysis that he uses in buying companies went into his choice of the Gates Foundation. He believes that the Gates Foundation can make better decisions about reducing inequities in the world and making a dent in the world's problems than he could personally make, and he saw no reason to set up a separate foundation when Gates is doing so well with the existing one. He trusts Bill and Melinda Gates, the world's wealthiest couple.

When you make a decision about philanthropic gifts, I hope you trust your church. Mr. Buffet's recent gift could operate our congregation's ministries for thirty one thousand years. But just on our own with our more humble means, we've worked effectively for one hundred seventy-two years, and we have a promising future of faithfulness in mission.

When you think about making a significant gift to the ministries of Jesus Christ through our church, you have at least three options. You can make a gift in your will to the **Permanent Memorial Fund** at Central, where it will be invested by our congregation's Board of Trustees for the benefit of the congregation. Currently the income earned by the Permanent Memorial Fund flows into the General Operating Fund of our church each year.

You can make a gift now or in the future to the **Community Foundation of Decatur** which accumulates and invests funds for a number of charities and benevolences in our town. Central was the first religious congregation to have a fund at the Community Foundation, thanks to the generosity of **Bob and Betty Campbell**.

You can purchase a gift annuity, paying you an income throughout your life, or make an outright gift to the **Christian Church Foundation** in Indianapolis with income earned by investing your gift flowing to Central for whatever purpose you designate. Central's Trustees invested \$90,000 with the Christian Church Foundation in 1998, and that fund has grown to \$103,000 while paying an income to the church.

Like Warren Buffett, you can turn to those you trust to make the most of your gift, whatever the amount. It is not necessary to give your entire fortune to Central, but some portion or percentage of your accumulated resources today or at some time in the future can strengthen the effectiveness of our church's ministries. And your gift in any amount to your church will be as fully appreciated and as gratefully received as Mr. Buffet's generosity.
